Physiological origin: Propagation of charges within the heart







Breathing Envelope

iAmp Device



Placing the electrodes and recording the signal

- 1. Place two electrodes on your right arm and one electrode in your left arm
- 2. Connect the Black and White cables to your Right arm and the Red cable to your Left arm.
- 3. To record switch on the iAmp (orange LED lights up) and press the start button (LED flashes at a high frequency);
- 4. To stop the recording, press start again
